### HOW TO GET HERE

**Parking:** The Venue does not have parking available. It is possible to drop off directly outside the venue. There is paid parking available 3 minute walk away.

**Bike:** Bike racks are available in front of the building or on the street.

**Overground:** 12 minute walk from Queens Road Peckham or Peckham Rye. Queens Road Peckham has step-free access to all platforms. Peckham Rye does not have step-free access.

**Bus:** 12, 36, 37, 63, 78, 136, 171, 177, 197, 343, 345, 363, 381, 436, N63, N89, N136, N171, N343, N381, P12, P13

**Tube:** The nearest tube Elephant & Castle is a 25 minute bus ride away.

Staffordshire Street is off of Peckham High Street, a busy four lane road. There are multiple pedestrian crossing points.

The venue is towards the end of Staffordshire Street, which is a one way residential road.

The road is quiet and has pavements on both sides. The pavement is narrow but wide enough for a wheelchair.

Outside the venue there is a drop curb.

When you arrive, you can enter the building using the main doors up steps.

There is step-free access to the gallery via the door to the left hand side of the main entrance. Please use the buzzer for assistance and a member of staff will meet you.

There is a wheelchair accessible toilet. This toilet is gender neutral.

There are male and female toilets.

The exhibition will be taking place in the main space, which is a large open room with bright lighting and fold out seating available.

The space can be quite echoey. If there are lots of people in the space it can get quite loud.

Ear plugs are available from the bar.
